GEORGE WILL TO SPEAK AS PART OF BUSINESS SCHOOL NAMING FESTIVITIES

George Will—Pulitzer Prize-winning author, newspaper columnist, journalist, and renowned political commentator—will speak at Lindenwood University at 7 p.m. on Thursday, May 7 in the J. Scheidegger Center for the Arts.

The address, titled “The Political Argument Today,” is part of the festivities surrounding the naming of the Robert W. Plaster School of Business & Entrepreneurship. Jamie Allman, of FM NewsTalk 97.1 and the Allman Report on KDNL-TV, will serve as master of ceremonies.
