Lindenwood University offers scholarships to members of DECA and other youth-oriented organizations by awarding numerous grants and scholarships to young adults that have excelled in service and leadership. More than \$1 million is provided annually to outstanding young adults through the program. The DECA Youth of the Year Award is worth \$12,400 plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn Award, the DECA Future Leader Award is worth \$6,000 plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn Award, the DECA Competitive Events Award is worth \$6,000 plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn Award, and the DECA Membership Award is worth \$5,000 plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn Award. All are annually renewable for up to four years.
