## -Media Alert-Lindenwood to Hold Groundbreaking Ceremony for \$21 million Library Building

St. Charles, Mo.—Lindenwood University will hold a groundbreaking ceremony its \$21 million Library and Academic Resources Center on the St. Charles Campus. The 100,000-square-foot building will be situated near the university's main entrance at First Capitol Drive and Kingshighway and will replace the 36,000-square-foot Margaret Leggat Butler Library, which was built in 1929. Completion is expected in the latter part of 2016.

The event will also mark the last public ceremony for President James D. Evans, who is retiring at the end of May after nine years on the job and 40 years at the university.
