You'll not only learn Operations, Procurement, Logistics, and Supply Chain Management, but you'll have the foundation of a well-rounded business degree, providing you maximum flexibility as you enter the business world.



For the second year in a row, the <u>online master</u> of fine arts degree in creative writing was ranked second in the country, only behind Harvard. The MFA in Writing, offered through the School of Accelerated Degree Programs, offers workshops, craft classes, and literature classes in small class settings, designed for individualized feedback, skill-building, and personal growth in a challenging but supportive environment. The degree is also available in a traditional classroom setting or hybrid classroom/online setting.



The <u>online master's degree in leadership</u> was

ranked #32 in the country. Students enrolled in the Master of Arts in Leadership program will develop skills in organizational change management, leadership strategies, organizational behavior, and strategic human resource management, all of which are critical skills for today's leaders.



The <u>online master's degree in public</u>

<u>administration</u> was <u>ranked #49 in the country</u>. The MPA program is a professional graduate program that prepares students to serve as managers in the executive arm of local, state, and federal/national government; the MPA is also useful if a student is interested in employment with an international organization or agency. The program includes courses in governmental budgeting, public finance and taxation, policy design, and more.
