LINDENLINK TAKES 16 AWARDS IN STATE JOURNALISM COMPETITION

April 30, 2020

Lindenwood students collected 16 awards from the Missouri College Media Association for journalistic articles, photos, videos and graphics that were published in *Lindenlink* in 2019.

The awards were announced by Association officials through Facebook the evening of April 7. The awards presentation originally was scheduled to be in Cape Girardeau during an annual conference of member schools, but the conference was canceled due to the spread of COVID-19.

The competition is divided into four groups of schools based on enrollments, and Lindenwood students competed in Division 1, the group that features schools with the largest enrollments. Schools competing in Division 1 included the University of Missouri, Missouri State University, St. Louis University and Washington University.

Lindenlink captured second place in the Division 1 sweepstakes category, a competition where schools are awarded points for each time a student places in an individual category. The sweepstakes winner for Division 1 was Missouri State University.

"I'm truly proud of these students and all of those who contributed to the website during the year," *Lindenlink* adviser Neil Ralston said. "Producing a variety of content week after week is an enormous job, and this competition against some of the biggest schools in the state shows that we can hold our own."

Kayla Drake, a senior journalism major who served as editor-in-chief in fall 2019, was named in 11 awards.

And the *Lindenlink* staff was awarded second place for best website in Division 1. The winning school in that category was the University of Missouri-Kansas City.
