PHI THETA KAPPA RECOGNIZES LINDENWOOD TRANSFER PATHWAYS

Lindenwood University has been named to the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society's Transfer Honor Roll for 2021. PTK recognizes the institutional commitment and resources available at Lindenwood to support transfer students.
