2021-22 EDUCATIONAL INVESTMENT COSTS ANNOUNCED

*With the rising costs of higher education, Lindenwood supports continued enrollment of students and is off setting the tuition increase for any returning, full-time undergraduate student who enrolls by June 1, or any new full-time undergraduate student who deposits by June 1. These students are eligible to receive a one-time \$540 priority registration grant applied to their bill, keeping the tuition cost even with the 2020-21 academic year.

Lindenwood University offers opportunities for students to reside on campus in several residential communities.
