ST. CHARLES, MO.--Novelist R. V. Cassill, professor of English at Brown University, will visit Lindenwood College on Wednesday, Oct. 25 as part of the school's creative writing program.

Cassill, author of a critical book on creative writing, will discuss this subject with Lindenwood students in the Fine Arts Lounge at 2 P.M. His talk is open to the public, without charge.

A columnist for Book Week, a Sunday supplement, his short stories and essays have appeared in virtually all of the major periodicals. His collections of short stories are entitled "The Fathers and Other Stories" and "Fifteen by Three.

His novels are "Pretty Leslie," "The President," and "Glen Anderson."

Cassill is the third in a series of visiting poets and writers who are being brought to the Lindenwood campus as part of the developing creative writing program at the four-year liberal arts college for women.
