FIGURE PAINTING EXHIBIT AT LINDENWOOD

An exhibit of oil and pastel nude figure paintings by Tito Gay (Virginia Gay Findlay) will be on display at The Lindenwood Colleges in St. Charles Oct. 5-28. The exhibit will be in the Lounge Gallery of the Fine Arts Building.

Ms. Gay attended Smith College, Washington University and the University of Wisconsin. She says, "My teacher at Washington University, Fred Conway, urged me to continue my studies at the National Academy School of Fine Arts in New York, where I was a student of Louis Bouche, Robert Philipp, and Raphael Soyer." From 1972 to 1976 she taught at Mary Institute. Since 1975 she has been an assistant professor of art at Fontbonne College.

Ms. Gay's work has appeared in many national exhibits including those sponsored by the American Watercolor Society, the Audubon Artists and the American Artists' Professional League Grand National. She has exhibited in two major shows in the St. Louis area.

Gallery hours are 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday; 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday; noon to 4 p.m. Saturday; and 1 to 4 p.m. Sunday. The exhibit is free and open to the public.
