Student/Teacher/Producer Wins Emmy

September 12, 1990 St. Charles, Mo.-- Carole Knight of St. Charles was awarded an Emmy for Best Program in the Performing Arts and Entertainment category. Knight produced the KETC-TV special "Concerto: The Whitaker Competition for Strings."

Knight, an associate producer at KETC, is an adjunct instructor of communications at Lindenwood College. She is working on her master of science degree in communications there as well. Knight received her bachelors degree in communications from Lindenwood in 1988. She was one of two recipients of the Walter Cronkite Scholarship from the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences in 1988, and received a NATAS scholarship in 1986.

Besides winning the Emmy for Best Program, the Concerto special was also nominated for Best Audio. Knight co-produced another nominee in the category for Best Children's Program, "Halloween Special." Last year, she received an Emmy nomination in the Best Student Program category.

Currently, Knight is producing the United Way Kick-Off Campaign telecast, scheduled to air September 17 on KETC. Formerly, Knight was co-producer for St. Louis Skyline on KETC and also worked at KMOV-TV as a production assistant and stage manager.
