The Director of the Lindenwood Evening College, Dr. Elwood L. Miller, announced the addition of two courses, American Economic History and Physical Science Concepts, to its four-week January Term evening schedule. Each January, a small number of courses are made available in the Evening College.

The courses offered are those that readily lend themselves to intensive study over a four-week term. Class sizes are limited, and both introductory and upper-division courses are scheduled. This January Term, there are seven courses in the evening schedule.

American Economic History will examine economic life and institutions in the United States from the colonial days. Economic growth, state and private authority in relation to economic activity, monetary and banking history, trade and commerce, industrial development, labor problems, transportation, land and agriculture policy.

Physical Science Concepts is a treatment of the concepts of the physical world, encompassing astronomy, physics, chemistry, and geology with attention to how these concepts are related and dependent upon each other. For elementary teacher trainees.
