The Fine Arts Building Gallery on The Lindenwood Colleges' campus will be the site of a show by Ms. Ruth Tempel entitled, "Creative Design in Fiber." Ms. Tempel, who describes herself as a crafts person and artist, will have her show on exhibit at Lindenwood from November 22 through December 17. This show is the third in the series of exhibits by women artists which evolved from the festival of "Women in the Arts." These exhibits will continue throughout the academic year at Lindenwood.

Ms. Tempel has won various awards for her work in a number of competitions, including the Carillon Art Walk in Maryland Plaza, the St. Charles Artists Guild Summer Show, the Lake St. Louis Festival, and the Missouri State Fair. She is past vice-president and president of the St. Charles Artists Guild and is represented in collections in Missouri, Illinois, Florida, California, and Virginia. She attended East Illinois University at Charleston, Illinois.

Her show at Lindenwood will be wall hangings and three-dimensionals created from natural fibers, using combinations of knotting techniques, weaving, and coiling. All items will be for sale.

The gallery hours will be 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays, and 12 noon to 5:30 p.m. on Sundays.
