The Lindenwood Colleges' Choir, the Lindenwood Orchestra, and the Lindenwood Singers, will present a Christmas Concert on December 8, at 8 p.m. in the Jelkyl Center for the Performing Arts on the campus. Dr. Kenneth Greenlaw, director of the 60-voice choir and Chairman of the college's Music Department, capsulized the program as one of "Renaissance and Baroque Christmas music, and sacred and secular carols sung with orchestra."

The program will feature both traditional and unfamiliar carols in both a cappella and orchestrally accompanied arrangements. In addition, a setting of the "Magnificat" by Buxtehude will be performed by the choir and orchestra.

The concert is free and the public is cordially invited.

On the 10th of December, the Choir will present a portion of this concert on the Georgian Staircase in the Saks Fifth Avenue store in Plaza Frontenac in suburban St. Louis. In addition to accepting this invitation to perform, the Choir has been asked by CBS radio to tape the concert program for radio presentation during the Christmas season. In the St. Louis/^{area}the CBS affiliate is KMOX radio.
