The Lindenwood Colleges and the Missouri State Council on the Arts will co-sponsor a series of workshops in Advanced Color Theory Application. These workshops will begin February 8 and will take place on five consecutive Saturdays through March 8. Advanced projects in color based on contemporary trends in painting will be created by the workshop participants. The sessions will be conducted by Ms. Mary Fifield, an instructor of art at Forest Park Community College. A teacher of design, color, composition, and drawing, Ms. Fifield received her Master of Fine Arts degree from Pratt Institute in New York. She has received a number of honors and awards, including a Ford Foundation Grant for a Faculty Fellowship in the Humanities in 1971.

The workshops are open to the St. Charles public who have had basic training in color theory and who are now ready to apply this theory to specific two and three-dimensional projects. These will be held in Room 210 of the Fine Arts Building on the campus from 9:30 a.m. to noon. For further information and registration, call the Lindenwood Art Department, 723-7152. Registrations must be made by January 31.

Lindenwood and the Missouri State Council on the Arts are also co-sponsoring a two-part photographic workshop. The first part of the workshop, Photographic Design, will deal with high contrast photography, posterization, half-tone printing, solarization, and other special effects, and will be conducted by Michael Eastman. This first part of the workshop will run from February 8 through March 8, Saturday mornings, 9 a.m. to 12 noon. The second part of the workshops will start immediately for a complete 10-week course.

The Art Department of The Lindenwood Colleges will offer a series of Wednesday workshops in painting on February 12, 19, and 26, March 5, 12, and 19, and April 2, 9, 16, and 23. Instruction, by St. Charles artist Madelyn Niedner, will be suited to the level of ability of each person. The student must furnish all materials. The cost of the workshop is \$50 if no credit is desired or \$75 for two credit hours.
