"Imitation and illusion give the art of Mime a sense of expectancy and excitement," says Lou Florimonte, Chairman of the Communication Arts Department at The Lindenwood Colleges, "and especially when performed by internationally-known mime artists like Bert Houle and Sophie Wibaux." Bert and Sophie will be artists-in-residence at The Lindenwood Colleges from February 10 through 12. They will give lecture-demonstrations and master classes in the art of mime, and a mini and major mime performance. The artists, who have studied mime techniques in France, have received some excellent reviews from their recent tour, added Mr. Florimonte.

On Monday, February 10, at 11 a.m. they will give a 45-minute mini-performance for high school students--cost of tickets is 50¢. That evening at 8 p.m. they will give a lecture-demonstration with tickets priced at \$1.25--group rates are available. These two events will take place in the Jelkyl Center for the Performing Arts in Roemer Hall on the campus. On Tuesday, February 11, Bert and Sophie will give two Master Classes in the Dance Studio of Lindenwood's Fine Arts Building, one at 2:30 p.m. and another at 8 p.m.--tickets are \$1.25. They will give their major performance called, "An Evening of Mime," at 8 p.m. on Wednesday, February 12. Tickets for this performance, which will take place in Jelkyl Center, are \$3.50, \$1.75 for students, and group rates are available.
