Dr. Howard A. Barnett has been named Special Assistant to the President at

The Lindenwood Colleges after six years as Vice President and Dean of the Faculty.

As Special Assistant to the President, Dr. Barnett's primary assignment will be to conduct a study of the church-college relationship with the objective of determining a new way in which the historic church-college partnership can be expressed. Other assignments will include liaison work with institutions in Missouri and other states. Dr. Barnett will continue teaching as Professor of English and beginning September 1975, he will resume full-time teaching at Lindenwood.

His tenure as Vice President and Dean of the Faculty has been highlighted by the development of career-oriented programs and individualized study, the extension of student internships into a variety of subject areas, the introduction of cooperative programs with near-by institutions, and the development of the Evening College.

Listed in WHO'S WHO IN AMERICA from 1964 to 1975, Dr. Barnett has been active in the Statewide Consortium on a Forum of Community Concerns funded through Title I, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Cooperative College Registry in Washington, D.C. He is a member of the Missouri State Committee for the Humanities and served as its chairman in 1973-74. Dr. Barnett's former responsibilities as dean of the faculty are being assumed by the deans of Lindenwood College for Women, Lindenwood College for Men, and the Evening College.
