"You say you're no artist, you can't draw? I say you can, and I'll show you how," says Jerry Warshaw, noted children's illustrator, who will give a presentation at The Lindenwood Colleges, in Young Science Hall Auditorium on Wednesday, March 19, at 7:30 p.m. Dorothy Haas, senior children's book editor from Rand McNally will also speak. Admission is free and it is open to the public.

Author of the "I Can't Draw Book," Warshaw's presentation will show teachers and librarians how to express themselves graphically and how to encourage students to express their thoughts in pictures. For illustration he will use a sound slide show based on the results of 9 year olds using the "I Can't Draw Book," and a chalk talk showing that you can too draw.

The presentation at Lindenwood is sponsored jointly by the St. Louis Suburban Librarians Association and The Lindenwood Colleges.
