An indoor Turkey Shoot will be held at The Lindenwood Colleges, on Saturday, April 12, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Turkey shoots are customarily held on outdoor trap ranges using clay pigeons, but at Lindenwood the Trap and Skeet Club has arranged for the public to use B-B guns and shoot at pinned-up targets from a bench rest position. Admission is free and the participation charge is three shots for \$1.

The Trap and Skeet Club will use the money raised to send Lindenwood's Trap and Skeet Team to the National Intercollegiate Meet in San Antonio, Texas, on April 19 and 20. The two-day competition, presented under the auspices of the Association of College Unions - International, Recreation Committee, will host participants from coast to coast. Lindenwood will be shooting against the Air Force Academy, West Point, and others. Last year 42 colleges participated.

The team is under the direction of Mrs. Sue Taylor, Assistant Professor of Physical Education at Lindenwood. The Lindenwood Trap and Skeet Club was formed in the fall of 1974.
